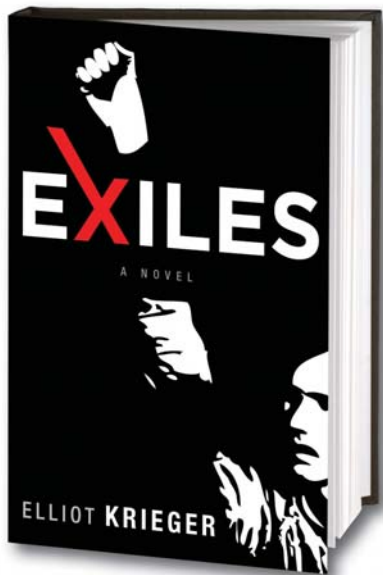

Beauty and danger go hand in hand in this ominous paradise

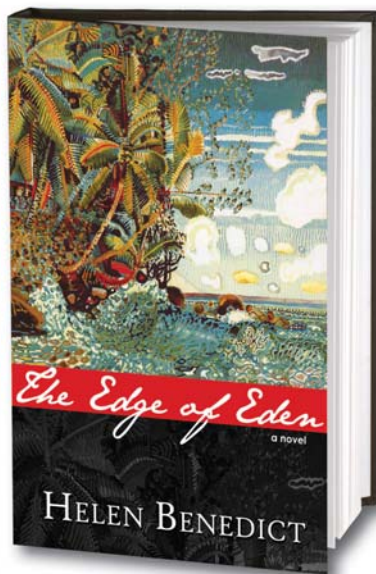

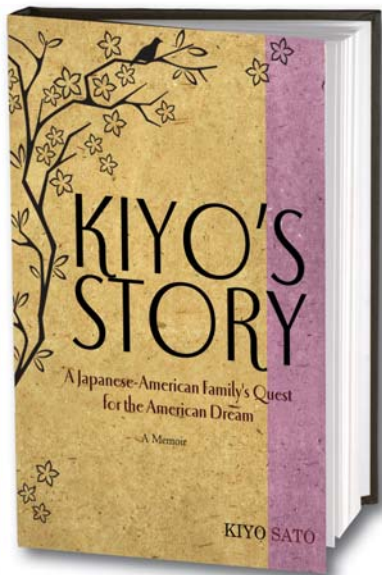

When Kiyoko's father left Japan, his mother told him never to return; there was no future there for him. Shinji Sato arrived in California determined to plant his roots in the Land of Opportunity even though he could not become a citizen.

He and his wife started a farm and worked in the fields together with their nine children. At the outbreak of World War II, when Kiyoko, the eldest, was eighteen, the Satos were uprooted and imprisoned at the Poston Internment Camp, though they had lived in the US for two decades and their children were citizens. Nearly a year later, Kiyoko was released with special permission to attend college, but after graduation she was rejected by many nursing schools due to her ethnicity. Eventually, she became a captain in the Army Nursing Corps and her siblings all became successful professionals. At long last when the laws changed, her parents became American citizens.

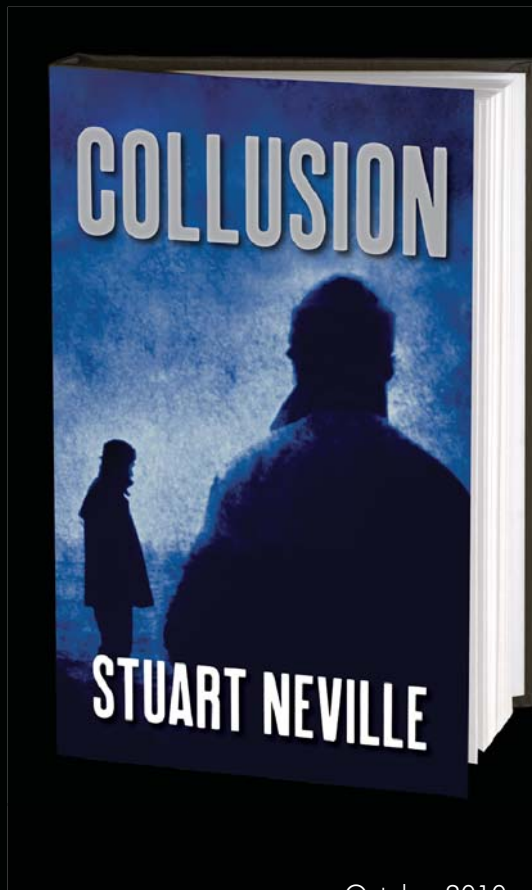

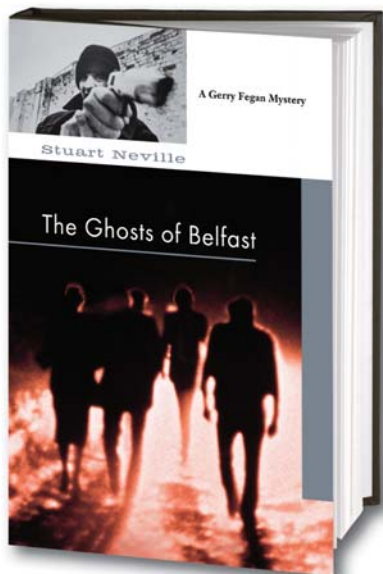

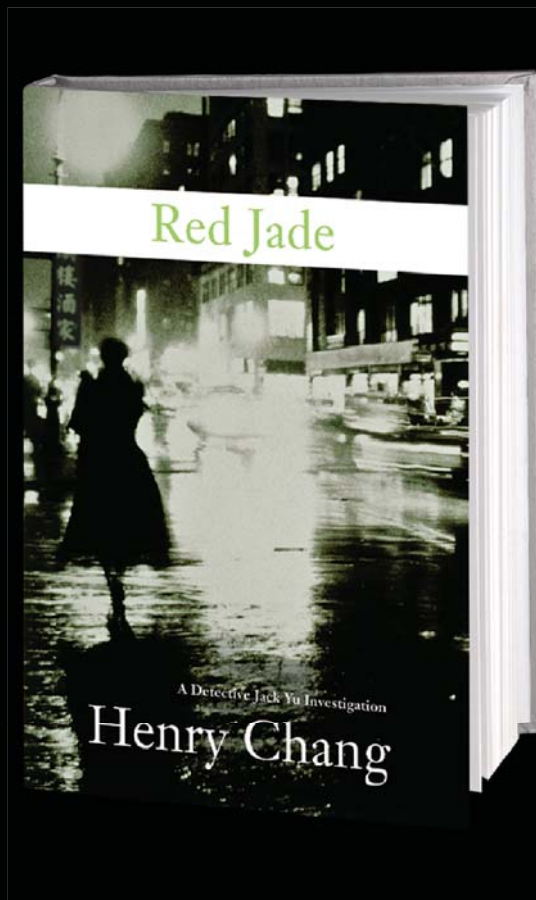
## HENRY CHANG
